To see if the Town will adopt the following resolution:  
A Resolution to Urge the Board of Selectmen to Put in Place an Historic Plaque at the Site of the Former St. Aidan's Church.

We all know that St. Aidan's is an historic church and the petitioner has been trying for years to see that a plaque be placed on the site.

We learned during the hearing that the plaque has been fabricated, approved by the Conservation Commission, and will be installed on April 12. The plaque commemorates the project, architecture, landscape, cultural history of the site and community process.

The wording on the plaque is attached to this brief write up. The capital subcommittee voted No Action on this article as it is our understanding that the plaque will be installed next week. Should this not happen, the subcommittee will reconsider its vote, but at this time we feel that no further action is necessary.
