- Beacon inbound to St Mary's (T Board discussion is continuing, **tentative Summer 2019 to discuss again**)
 - Pearl Street (**Contract awarded and construction will begin in April 2019**)

 - ♻ Essex-Dummer Intersection (**Contract awarded; construction will begin late Spring 2019**)
 - ♻ Ivy and St Mary's Streets (proceeding through the CIP approval process; if approved construction late Summer/Fall 2019)
 - ♻ Hammond Street (Concept **design presented to Transportation Board March 2019. Board requested revised concept designs and additional analysis from consultant. Expected Summer 2019**)
 - ♻ Beacon Street outbound Town line to Carlton (staff developing drawings for public process and possible FY 2021 funding)
 - ♻ Harvard Street (changes in Brookline Village Spring 2019; other changes are candidates for FY 2021 CIP request)
 - ♻ Intersection of Beacon and Washington (possible candidate for FY 2021 CIP request)
 - ♻ Washington Street (expected for funding FY 2020-2024; not yet reviewed)
 - Beacon Street at Washington St. protected bike lane demo (Spring 2019)
 - Lane violation/loading zones (Harvard, Beacon to Green, Staff reviewing options. Stantec reviewing as possible mitigation for the Waldo project)
 - Parking meter stickers (Stickers installed May & June 2019)
 - Curbside bike lane signs (Centre Street completed. Others to be processed starting Spring 2019.)
 - Winchester Street Fuller to Beacon (to be completed after National Grid completes their project)
 - Green Street (request submitted to staff July 10, 2018. Staff to **present plans to BAC Spring 2019**)
 - Beacon Street Bridle Path (TM approved non-binding resolution calling for funding source and scope by May 2020. Demo being developed for Bike Week/Climate Action **Event on May 18th from Carlton Street to Kent Street**. Other future demos also possible in summer/fall 2019)
 - Bike rack snow removal (Twelve high priority racks on DPW snow clearance protocol)
 - Bicycle education project (Pamphlet content outlined; processing with Town and seeking merchant support)
 - **Driscoll School project (Transportation Board approved final Transportation mitigation measures. Some require MassDOT approval)**
 - **Baldwin School project (Transportation Board will take up Transportation mitigation measures on April 22nd)**
