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Background

The passage of the MBTA Communities Act ("MBTA-CA") in 2022 requires municipalities like Brookline to create a zoning district that allows multi-family development without special permits. Our Department is proposing to meet this requirement by leveraging analysis already completed that identified regulatory barriers to multifamily and mixed-use development and proposed remedies that can serve as an objective basis for community visioning workshops. The first installment of this study is [Harvard Street](#), a vital mixed-use neighborhood.

This is the second of several scheduled collaborative workshops to explore other community ideas for compliance beyond Harvard Street. Additionally, the Select Board is scheduled to appoint a Committee to explore other compliance options on April 18th.
