This includes collecting and assessing the pavement condition for all town owned public ways, sidewalk, and ramps. Additionally, the Department has completed an ADA/PROWAG compliance assessment for all sidewalks and handicap ramps. The Department's primary goal is to establish benchmarks and coordinate infrastructure improvements to leverage available funding in an efficient, effective and transparent manner benefitting all residents, businesses and visitors.
