

RECORD OF THE EMERGENCY MEETING OF THE BROOKLINE SCHOOL COMMITTEE ON **SUNDAY, MAY 15, 2022** AT 1:00 PM (REMOTE VIA ZOOM). STATUTORY NOTICE OF THIS MEETING WAS FILED WITH THE TOWN CLERK.

Mr. Pearlman called the meeting to order at 1:00 PM.

1. PROPOSED EXECUTIVE SESSION

By unanimous roll call vote at 1:00 PM, the School Committee entered into Executive Session pursuant to Massachusetts General laws chapter 30A section 21(a) for the following purposes: Purpose 3, to discuss strategy with respect to collective bargaining with the Brookline Educators Union (BEU) Unit A, Unit B, and Paraprofessionals because the Chair declared that an open meeting may have a detrimental effect on the bargaining or litigating position of the public body. Mr. Pearlman announced that the meeting will not reconvene in open session at the end of the Executive Session. By unanimous roll call vote at 3:15 PM, with 9 in favor (Mr. Pearlman, Dr. Liu, Ms. Charlupski, Dr. Ehrenberg, Ms. Federspiel, Ms. Frias, Ms. Gorer, Ms. Monopoli, and Ms. Nobrega), 0 opposed, and 0 abstentions, the School Committee reconvened in open session for the purpose of adjournment.
