

RECORD OF THE MEETING OF THE BROOKLINE SCHOOL COMMITTEE ON **THURSDAY, MARCH 24, 2022** AT 5:00 PM (REMOTE VIA ZOOM). STATUTORY NOTICE OF THIS MEETING WAS FILED WITH THE TOWN CLERK.

Ms. Federspiel called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM.

1. PROPOSED EXECUTIVE SESSION

By unanimous roll call vote at 5:00 PM, the School Committee entered into Executive Session pursuant to Massachusetts General laws chapter 30A section 21(a) for the following purposes: Purpose 3, to discuss strategy with respect to collective bargaining with the Brookline Educators Union (BEU) Unit A (Grievances) because the Chair declared that an open meeting may have a detrimental effect on the bargaining or litigating position of the public body, and Purpose 2, to conduct a collective bargaining session with the BEU Unit A (Hearing on Grievances). Ms. Federspiel announced that the meeting will not reconvene in open session at the end of the Executive Session. By unanimous roll call vote at 6:00 PM, with 7 in favor (Ms. Federspiel, Mr. Pearlman, Ms. Charlupski, Ms. Ditkoff, Dr. Ehrenberg, Ms. Frias, and Dr. Liu), 0 opposed, and 0 abstentions, the School Committee reconvened in open session for the purpose of adjournment.
