Holiday Collection Delays

The collection schedule is interrupted in the event of a legal holiday. Residents shall place items out for collection one (1) day later than their usual collection day. Friday collection moves to Saturday.

Curbside Collection

Place carts curbside by 7:00am on collection day. Trash and recycling must be contained in Town-issued carts.

Recycling

Use your **blue cart** for paper (newspaper, magazines, mail, etc.), plastic containers (#1-7), milk cartons, cardboard, and glass.

Trash

Use your **black cart** for food waste, paper towels, and other non-recyclable items. If your cart is full, use a **purple overflow bag** (see back cover).

Bulky Items

Call to schedule: (617) 730-2156.

Bulky items are picked up on collection day, by appointment only, and must be scheduled one (1) week in advance. The DPW will pick-up items such as furniture, white goods, stoves, refrigerators, AC units, and TVs.

Yard Waste

April 1st - December 31st

Place yard waste in either a paper Yard Waste bag, or in a container labeled as yard waste. **Fill With:** Leaves, grass clippings, shrub trimmings, plant cuttings, etc.
