I am writing in firm opposition to the current proposed plans for development of 1299 Beacon Street.

Either current plan for a hotel or a residential/retail building would have a potentially deadly effect on the public's safety. Longwood Avenue is a main thoroughfare for ambulances en route to the Longwood Medical Area. Currently their progress is very often impeded by traffic caused by Trader Joe's shoppers trying to enter/exit the parking lot, delivery trucks parked illegally on Longwood Avenue blocking the right lane and back up from the congestion caused by the postal trucks on Sewall Street. For many patients on board the ambulances minutes could mean the difference between life and death.

Either plan presents an enormous increase in traffic in an already tremendously congested area with potentially deadly consequences. I know, I've observed this first hand for nearly 16 years!
