I've lived in Brookline for the past twenty years (on Winchester Street in Coolidge Corner) and have watched its continued growth during that time.

Although I am pleased that the area has remained vibrant and continues to grow in diversity of both population and commercial ventures, I am dismayed by the increase in traffic, difficulty in finding parking spaces, and number of new construction sites. I agree that Brookline needs more affordable housing, but building new structures, like the one proposed for 1299 Beacon Street, will only increase existing congestion and parking issues without providing a significant enough number of affordable units to make the project worth the harm it will do.

I oppose this new construction and hope to voice my opposition at the public meetings scheduled over the next six months.
