## Helping you access the tools you need

Parking Access for Resident's Caregiver (P.A.R.C.) is a service provided through the Brookline Council on Aging, in cooperation with the Town of Brookline Transportation Department. The goal of this program is to provide assistance in obtaining temporary parking permits for caregivers.

### Program Eligibility

In order to receive service from P.A.R.C., participants must meet the following criteria:

1. Brookline Resident, or a
2. Caregiver for a Brookline Resident, and be/have a
3. Caregiver who drives, whose working time exceeds 2 hours or work overnight.

### Getting Started



The use of this service is free of charge. You will be linked with a Council on Aging licensed, Masters level social worker who will be able to assist in navigating the application process for a temporary parking permit.

Parking permits are temporary, and will need to be renewed every six (6) months.

Some personal information will be needed to complete this application. Such as:

- Resident Name, Address, and telephone number
- Caregiver name, make/model of car, and plate number.
- Reason for need
