PEARL STREET CONSTRUCTION NOTICE *Construction Begins Week of June 3*

Dear Pearl Street Neighbor,

On Monday, June 3rd, the Town's contractor, I. W. Harding, will mobilize to Pearl Street and begin construction.

Project Details

- Improve deteriorating roadway and sidewalks infrastructure
- Provide improved facilities for cyclists and pedestrians
- Construct curb extensions and raised crossing to enhance pedestrian safety
- Upgrade street lighting
- New street trees

Project Schedule

- The project will take approximately 3 months to complete
- During the week of June 3rd, crews will mobilize to the site and remove trees and install signage
- New drainage structures will be installed in June.
- Crews will then begin removing sections of sidewalk, roadway, and curbing

What to expect during construction

- General work hours will be 7 AM to 5 PM, Monday – Friday.
- “No Parking” signs will be posted at least 24 hours in advance of construction; please be sure to check posted signs for exact dates and times.
- Section of the road will be temporary closed.
- When work occurs directly in front of driveways or entryways, the contractor and police details will coordinate access directly with residents and businesses.
- Emergency vehicles will have access at all times.
