PEARL STREET CONSTRUCTION UPDATE *Week of June 10*

Dear Pearl Street Neighbor,

The following is an update of the construction work planned for next week

- Street light work will begin on Monday June 10. Crews will install the underground infrastructure for the lights along 5 and 10 Brookline Place .
- Crews will continue to remove sections of sidewalk, roadway, and curbing
- New concrete sidewalks are scheduled to be placed on Thursday (weather permitting)

What to expect during construction

- **The road will be closed to thru traffic** during general working hours (7AM to 5 PM, Monday – Friday)
- Emergency vehicles and deliveries will have access at all times.
- When work occurs directly in front of driveways or entryways, the contractor and police details will coordinate access directly with residents and businesses.
- Access to the parking garage at 10 Brookline Place will be from Washington Street
- All vehicles exiting the Parking garage at 1 Brookline Place should drive toward Brookline Ave.
