



Below is a chart which illustrates Brookline Green (standard/default product) rates compared to Eversource residential rates since the beginning of the program in July 2017. Eversource's Basic Service supply rates change every six months for residential and small business customers, and every three months for large business customers. As a result, Brookline Green cannot guarantee future savings when compared to Eversource Basic Service. However, as shown below, the Brookline Green Standard Product has been below Residential Eversource Basic Service in all but two rate periods, while also purchasing more renewable energy.



## Opt-Up to 100%

Opting up to Brookline All Green means that all the electricity you use will come from non-polluting renewable energy generated in New England. Even participating customers with solar panels further the program's goals by increasing the renewable energy purchased in months where electricity is purchased. Our competitive rates make this choice easier. For just over \$12 per month, the average Brookline household using 539 kWh monthly could displace the equivalent of emissions produced by driving 3,681 miles in a typical passenger vehicle per year\*. ## History of Brookline Green Electricity

In summer 2017, the Town of Brookline proudly launched Brookline Green, a Community Electricity Aggregation (CEA), a program officially approved by the Town and the MA Department of Public Utilities. Brookline elected officials, Town staff, as well as a working advisory group of local residents have worked diligently on your behalf to bring this program to fruition. The program uses bulk-purchasing methods to procure electricity for Town residents at stable, competitive rates, while offering more renewable energy product options. We are grateful for your participation in the program and are delighted to report that over the course of the initial 30-month contract, the default Brookline Green Program, compared to the standard Eversource product, has cost less money (\$1.5 million annually) while also reducing climate-changing greenhouse gas emissions by 28,872 tons.
