Vanasse & Associates, Inc. (VAI) requested crash reports from the Brookline Police Department (BPD) for the latest 5-years of crash data available at the intersections of Harvard Street with Kenwood Street, Harvard Street with the site driveway, and Kenwood Street with the site driveway. Initially, the BPD indicated that due to the COVID-19 situation they were not responding to crash data requests. However, BPD recently provided the results of their research.

The BPD research indicated one crash occurred over that five-year period; however, this crash did not actually occur at any of the study area locations. The crash report indicates that the crash took place on August 16, 2017 at 525 Harvard Street which is north of the intersection with Kenwood Street by approximately 250 feet and is adjacent to the intersection of Harvard Street with Verndale Street. The incident involved a car and a scooter. The person on the scooter was yelling at the person in the car and pounding on the glass of the car about a prior traffic incident. In an attempt to get away from the person on the scooter the person driving the car which was parked on the side of Harvard Street attempted to pull out onto Harvard Street and in the process struck the scooter causing it to fall over. No injuries were reported. The crash report is available upon request.
