TEMPORARY PARKING PERMIT

ROADWAY PAVING

WINCHESTER ST - PUBLIC NOTICE

On Saturday September 26, 2020 *weather permitting*, the contractor; Charles' Contracting Co., Inc. will be PAVING the section of Winchester Street from Fuller St to Williams St.

If you need to use your vehicles during the day, please move them OUT OF YOUR DRIVEWAY and off the street **BY 10AM FRIDAY 9/25**. The temporary driveway ramps will be removed Friday afternoon and you will not have driveway access again until the work is complete on Saturday. Work will begin at 8:00 AM and proceed until 4:00 PM. Vehicles will not be allowed on the street until work is finished. Brookline police details will be on hand, as necessary to assist abutting residents with any implemented traffic detours or parking restrictions.

ALL WORK IS WEATHER DEPENDENT

This notice can be used as a TEMPORARY PARKING PERMIT for residents who are unable to move their vehicles during the hours of construction. To use this as a parking permit, residents must place this notice underneath the driver side windshield of the car and **park on an abutting street** that is not including the paved street. Brookline Police have been notified.
