Hi Maria,

Our group of neighbors would like to ask the ZBA to consider putting these conditions on the 500 Harvard development.

We ask that the developer secure parking spots for trucks and personal vehicles of workers that are not on the neighboring streets. This would reduce the risks of accidents to the population that uses the park, of which many are children, and would reduce problems for residents who cannot exit their driveways if trucks are parked on the opposite side of the street. Also, if there are any interruptions in power or street closures, we ask that those affected be notified in advance.

The other requests concern reducing the impacts of the building. We are asking that the lighting plan of the building not emphasize the building's height the way the lighting at 455 Harvard does, that it fit into the streetscape of Harvard St. and that it not be intrusive to the abutting neighborhood. We also request that balconies not overlook the Kenwood St. abutter, and do not intrude on the privacy of neighboring back yards.
