The Preservation Commission received **an application for a Demolition Certificate for the full demolition of the house at 92 Sewall Avenue on August 25th, 2021**. In accordance with Section 5.3 of the Town's By-law, the Commission staff, in consultation with the Chair, made an initial determination as to whether the building in question falls into one or more of the categories listed under paragraphs a-d in Section 5.3.5 and which identifies a building as significant. In the case of **the house at 92 Sewall Avenue**, the property's significance meets the following criteria in Section 5.3.5—

- c. The building is associated with one or more significant historic persons or events, or with the broad architectural, cultural, political, economic, or social history of the town or Commonwealth; and
- d. The building is historically or architecturally significant in terms of its period, style, method of construction, or its association with a significant architect or either by itself or as part of a group of buildings.

This letter serves as notification of the staff's initial determination of significance of the **house at 92 Sewall Avenue**. Pursuant to section 5.3.7 of the By-law, a **public hearing** for review the case will be held on **Tuesday September 29th, 2021 at 6:30PM**.

All public hearings are currently **scheduled to take place virtually on Zoom Webinar**, the town's online public hearing platform.
