The Brookline Zoning Board of Appeals will hold a virtual public hearing on **Monday, July 12, 2021 at 7:00 PM** to open a hearing on an application for a Comprehensive Permit submitted to the Town of Brookline by Hebrew Senior Life, in accordance with M.G.L c.40B, to construct a new six-story building with 54 units age-restricted (62+ yrs) residential rental units (100% affordable) and no parking spaces at **108 Centre Street. (Precinct 9)**
