

Community Partnership Committee Program Standard Bearers

Approximately 25 Brookline High School students including many members of the school's boys' and girls' golf teams (varsity and junior varsity) will serve as standard bearers during the week of the Championship. All of the students on the Brookline High School golf team as well as the entire senior class were able to register to take advantage of this exciting opportunity. Each standard bearer is responsible for carrying a scoring sign with every group of players during the championship. The standard will show each player's score in relation to par. All Standard Bearers walk alongside an experienced adult walking Scorer. In addition to a terrific once-in-a-lifetime experience, all Standard Bearers will receive their apparel package free of charge.

Details of program:

- Each Standard Bearer will volunteer for a minimum of 3 shifts.
- Approximately 13 Brookline junior volunteers needed per day during the first and second rounds of play (Thursday and Friday).
- Approximately 8 Brookline junior volunteers needed per day during the third and final rounds of play (Saturday and Sunday).
- Ideally, these Brookline junior volunteers will have a basic working knowledge of golf and should be able to walk five (5) miles each shift in various weather conditions.
