This notice is to remind you the Town's contractor will be lining the existing sewer on Monmouth St. between Monmouth Ct., on Thursday, March 31, 2011.

To avoid the possibility of sewerage backing up during this period, please minimize the quantity of liquids going down your drains.

This interruption in sewer service will be from: 9:00 am to 3:00 pm
