The Town of Brookline is designing a replacement for the Davis Path Footbridge. The goal of the current process, begun in September of 2022, is to present a 25% design for consideration by the Select Board by Spring of 2023. The Town is working closely with a Design Review Committee and consultant team to develop this design. A series of virtual Design Review Committee meetings and a Site Visit Open House, both of which are open to the public, are scheduled to take place over the next several months to gather public input for the evolving concept design for the new footbridge and Davis Path connection.
