The keeping of bees (*species Apis Mellifera*), provided that no hive may be less than 20 feet from any window, door, or other opening in any structure on any other lot; and further provided that no hive be within six feet of any lot line or placed in a location visible from the street; and subject to such ~~requirements~~restrictions as may be imposed by the Director of Public Health of the Town of Brookline, including, but not limited to, requirements as to number, ~~and as to~~ location and size of special structures and enclosures, ~~as may be imposed by the Director of Public Health of the Town of Brookline.~~ No beehive shall be placed upon a lot nor retained on a lot without a current permit provided by the Director of Public Health of the Town of Brookline.

This new Accessory Use will be permitted in every zoning district
