TOWN COUNCIL SUMMARY: If passed, this local ballot question would limit the number of storefront marijuana retailer licenses in the Town to four or less. The November 2022 Special Town Meeting passed this proposed bylaw as Warrant Article 15. State law requires that the Town of Brookline voters decide whether to adopt this bylaw change. General Laws, c. 94G, § 3(e). The license cap will stay unchanged for all other license types. These other license types include marijuana delivery operators, social consumption retailers, and marijuana couriers. The present license cap for each license type equals 20% of the number of liquor licenses for off-premises alcohol consumption that the Select Board has issued. Today, the cap is five.

A "yes" vote on this question would limit the number of storefront marijuana retailer licenses in the Town to four or less.

A "no" vote would make no changes to the number of storefront marijuana retailer licenses in the Town.

TOWN COUNCIL SUMMARY: If passed, this local ballot question would limit the number of storefront marijuana retailer licenses in the Town to four or less. The November 2022 Special Town Meeting passed this proposed bylaw as Warrant Article 15. State law requires that the Town of Brookline voters decide whether to adopt this bylaw change. General Laws, c. 94G, § 3(e). The license cap will stay unchanged for all other license types. These other license types include marijuana delivery operators, social consumption retailers, and marijuana couriers. The present license cap for each license type equals 20% of the number of liquor licenses for off-premises alcohol consumption that the Select Board has issued. Today, the cap is five.

A "yes" vote on this question would limit the number of storefront marijuana retailer licenses in the Town to four or less.

A "no" vote would make no changes to the number of storefront marijuana retailer licenses in the Town.
