(A) In place of the amendment proposed by TMM Marty Rosenthal, the Board of Selectmen approved alternative language that was approved by the Advisory Committee and Town Meeting. The alternative language comes at the end of Special Appropriation #48: "provided that the Department of Public Works and Transportation Board provide status reports to the Board of Selectmen on a quarterly basis."

(B) The Board of Selectmen, Advisory Committee, and Town Meeting voted No Action on TMM Bruce Wolff's amendment.

(C) The Board of Selectmen and the Advisory Committee voted No Action on the proposed amendment from TMM Roger Lipson.

(D) The motion offered by the Petitioner differed from the motion of the Board of Selectmen and Advisory Committee in Section 3.19.2: the Petitioner's motion used the word "attend" whereas the Board of Selectmen and Advisory Committee used "participate in". The Petitioner's language was approved by Town Meeting.

(E) The Board of Selectmen and the Advisory Committee voted Favorable Action on the proposed amendment from the Moderator's Committee on FAR.
