INSTRUCTIONS FOR DOG LICENSE AND OFF – LEASH GREEN DOG PROGRAM

To apply or renew online please read the instructions at https://www.brooklinema.gov/Permits-and-Licensing

Please READ the following instructions in order to avoid inconvenience and additional cost to you at a later date:

DO NOT IGNORE THIS FORM	1	M.G.L.,Ch 140 § 137 and General By-Law 8.6 requires all owners or keepers of dogs to license them annually by March 31 st. You must license your dog, even if it never leaves your property. A late fee of \$20.00 will be assessed as of April 1 st .					
AGE TIME and LICENSE	2	Any person who becomes the owner or keeper of a dog six months old or over during any license period shall cause it to be licensed. Failure to license a dog may result in penalties of up to \$75.00 independent of the late fee.					
VACCINATION	3	You must provide one of the following: (1) a current rabies certificate or (2) a notarized letter from a veterinarian that a vaccination certificate was issued, in order to process your application.					
FEE	4a	Dog License \$20.00 4b Dog License <u>AND</u> Optional Off-Leash Green Dog Program: \$120.00					
LICENSES	5	Licenses cannot be issued to persons under 18 years of age.					
FINES	6	Between April 1 st and May 31 st of each year the Animal Control Officer will begin a door-to-door survey of unlicensed dogs. Delinquent owners or keepers of dogs may be fined up to \$75.00 for each unlicensed dog independent of the late fee.					
WARRANT TO ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER	7	Within 10 days after June 1 st of each year, a warrant shall be issued by the Select Board and given to the Animal Control Officer to seek out, catch and confine all unlicensed dogs (M.G.L. Ch. 140 § 151A).					
BREED OF DOG	8	Do not put "mix" or "mongrel" for breed of dog. We need a clear description if your dog strays (i.e. Shepherd/Collie mix or Doberman/Retriever mix).					
GREEN DOG PROGRAM	9	In order to take advantage of off-leash hours and locations, each participating dog must be enrolled. To enroll: (1) Dog must be 6 months or older (2) Select "Dog License and Optional Green Dog Program."					
PAYMENT	10	Make check or money order payable to the TOWN OF BROOKLINE (DO NOT SEND CASH) and mail to TOWN CLERK, 333 WASHINGTON ST, BROOKLINE, MA 02445 Or Renew Online.					
SERVICES OFFERED	11	Lost/Found information, health care information, licensing information, cruelty investigation, and complaint investigation (See Reverse Side).					

PLEASE REVIEW THE DATA ON THE INCLUDED APPLICATION, MAKE CORRECTIONS AS NECESSARY, AND RETURN WITH THE FEE.

Your dog is lost . . . now what do you do?

- First, contact the **Brookline Police Animal Control Officer**! **(617) 730-2222**. If s/he is not available, ask to leave your name, a description of your dog, and your contact information with the call taker. Ask that this information be **logged in**, in case someone sees your dog and calls the police.
- Post a free, widely distributed notice in both the "Lost and Found" and "Pets" sections of Craigslist at: http://boston.craigslist.org/
- Print several hundred Lost Dog Flyers on brightly colored, neon paper, assemble friends and family, and post them (not on trees) within at least a one to two mile radius of where your dog went missing. You will likely need permission to do this; and it is important to make a firm commitment to take them down as soon as your dog is found. If bad weather is expected, insert them in clear plastic sleeve protectors available at office supply stores, with the opening facing down to keep them dry. Be sure that the contact number appearing on the flyer can be monitored by someone 24/7.
- Contact local animal shelters! Local shelters include the VCA Brookline Animal Hospital (617) 277-2030; the City of Boston Shelter (617) 635-1800; the MSPCA Boston Animal Shelter (617) 522-5055 and the Animal Rescue League Boston Shelter (617) 426-9170. Again, be sure to leave your name, a description of your dog, and your contact information. Be sure to call or visit these shelters frequently!
